WHEREAS, it is desirable to amend By-Law 18-18, to extend the terms of the Integrity Commissioner agreement (the "Agreement").

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AYLMER HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That, subject to execution of the attached Amendment to the Agreement dated January 1, 2018, the Agreement is extended for a period of two years expiring on December 31, 2020; and further,

That an annual retainer is paid in the amount of \$750.

2. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect as of the date of its final passing.

**AMENDMENT**  
**To the Agreement dated January 1, 2018**

Between:

The Corporation of the Town of Aylmer  
(hereinafter referred to as the "Municipality")

Of the first part

– and –

Lisa Korab of the law firm Korab Law  
(hereinafter referred to as the "IC")

Of the second part

**Whereas:**

- (A) The Municipality has requested a two year extension of the one year appointment of Lisa Korab as Integrity Commissioner for the Municipality as set out in the Agreement dated January 1, 2018 also referred to as "Schedule "A" to By-Law #18-18 ("the Agreement" );
- (B) And whereas the IC has agreed to continue to provide IC services;

The Parties hereby agree to an extension of the Agreement on the following terms:

1. Extension

The extension of the Agreement shall be for an additional two year term to December 31, 2020;

2. Retainer

Upon execution of this Amendment, extending the IC appointment for a further two year period, the Municipality shall pay to the IC a retainer fee in the amount of \$750.00 per annum. The retainer fee is non-refundable even if there is early termination of the appointment by either party.

3. Early Termination

The Agreement may be terminated by either party by providing one month written notice to the other party at any time.

4. Terms and Conditions

All of the terms and conditions of the previous agreement shall remain in force and effect, unless specifically changed herein.
