(Section 232 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*)


I, **Pete Barbour**, having been elected to the office of Councillor in the municipality of the Town of Aylmer do solemnly promise and declare that:


1. I will truly, faithfully and impartially exercise this office to the best of my knowledge and ability.
