

Be Courteous to Your Neighbours

The Open-Air Burning By-Law shall be administered by the Fire Chief or designate, By-Law Enforcement Officer and Police Officers of the Town of Aylmer.

If an Officer is satisfied that this by-law has been contravened, the Officer may issue an Order to Extinguish requiring the person contravening the by-law to immediately extinguish the fire.


QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

OPEN-AIR RECREATIONAL FIRES REMEMBER THESE RULES:

- Placed on non-combustible material.
- Fire is in a contained site & 3m/10ft from a structure or adjacent property.
- Use charcoal or clean, dry wood, or commercially manufactured fuels designed for this purpose only.
- A responsible person must be present to attend and supervise the fire at all times.
- An extinguishing agent must be available.
- Only between sunrise and midnight.



OPEN-AIR RECREATIONAL FIRES ARE NOT PERMITTED:

- When wind speeds exceed 20 km per hour
- During rainy or foggy weather
- When a smog alert has been issued
- During a fire ban



Open-Air Recreational Fires are not to cause smoke/and or odour nuisance to neighbouring residences or buildings or cause decreased visibility on any street or roadway.

FLYING LANTERNS



No person shall ignite and release or use a Flying Lantern within the boundaries of the Town of Aylmer

OPEN-AIR COOKING FIRES

REMEMBER THESE RULES:

- In a non-combustible container or barbeque.
- Not be located on a covered porch or veranda, or on a balcony of a multi-residential unit.
- Use charcoal or clean, dry wood, or commercially manufactured fuels designed for the purpose of cooking foods only.
- Adjacent properties are not adversely affected by the products of combustion.
- Not near dry vegetation.
- A responsible person must be present to attend and supervise the fire at all times.



Fire not to exceed 2 ft wide x 2 ft long 1 ft height in burning materials
