### Statutory Holidays:

- December 25, 2025 - waste pickup will be on December 29, 2025
  - January 1, 2026 - waste pickup will be on January 5, 2026
- All other pickups for 2025 remain the same

### Brush Curbside Collection

April 14 to 17 (Monday to Thursday)  
& September 22 to September 25 (Monday to Thursday)

- Brush will be picked up the day prior to your regular garbage day and must be placed out prior to 7 a.m.
- Brush only will be picked up.
- Brush must not exceed 1.4 meters (4.5 feet) in length and must be bundled and tied.

### Yard Waste Curbside Collection

April 21 to 24 (Monday to Thursday)

- Yard waste will be picked up the day prior to your garbage day and must be placed out prior to 7 a.m.
- Yard waste must be placed in paper biodegradable bags and not exceed 20 kg (44 lbs).
- Includes such items as plant material, leaves and grass clippings.

### Curbside Swap - New Initiative!

May 16, 17, 18, 19 (Friday to Monday)  
& September 26, 27, 28 (Friday to Sunday)

\*Stay tuned on social media for more dates!

- Place unwanted items curbside to give others the chance to find a new home for your items.
- This program aims to divert items from the landfill site and offers another way to reuse items.
- Please do not place items on the curb other than days and times specified.
- Items are the responsibility of the resident to discard if they remain after the curbside swap.

### Large Item Curbside Collection

September 30 & October 1, 2, 3 (Tuesday to Friday)

\*Downtown businesses and apartments above businesses will be picked up on Tuesday, September 30

- Items will be picked up on your regularly scheduled garbage day and must be placed out prior to 7 a.m.
- The intent of this program is to dispose of a reasonable amount of items that are too large for the regular garbage collection stream.
- Items shall be contained neatly to the curbside.
- If you are placing any container(s) to the curbside that is not intended for disposal, please print your address clearly on the container in large letters.
- Any device bearing Freon/CFC must have a certificate from a licensed appliance dealer noting that the freon has been removed.
- Roll material into secured compact rolls/bundles not exceeding 4.5 ft in length and 2.5 feet in diameter.
- Unacceptable Items: Waste from other collection events, construction, demolition, and renovation material, electronics, hazardous waste.
  - Drywall, wood, shingles, tires, propane tanks, concrete, oil, additional garbage bags, etc.
- Acceptable Items: furniture, outdoor living, sports & recreation equipment, etc.

### Fall Leaf Collection

October 27 to November 21 (weather dependent)

- There is no defined route, however several trips will be made throughout the Town during the specified dates.
- The Town's preference is for residents to use bio-degradable paper bags for the curbside leaf collection.
- Unlimited number of bags will be collected.

### Christmas Tree Drop-off Depot

January 1 to 3 and December 26 to 31 - 8 Parkview Heights

- Please remove all tinsel and decorations before drop-off.

## REGULAR GARBAGE COLLECTION

- Waste must be set to the curb prior to 7 a.m.
- Each residential unit is permitted a total of three untagged bags of garbage once weekly.
- One of the three untagged bags can be yard waste.
- Yard waste must be in a biodegradable bag.
- Additional bags over the untagged bag limit must be tagged.
- Weight restriction of 20kg (44lbs) per bag.

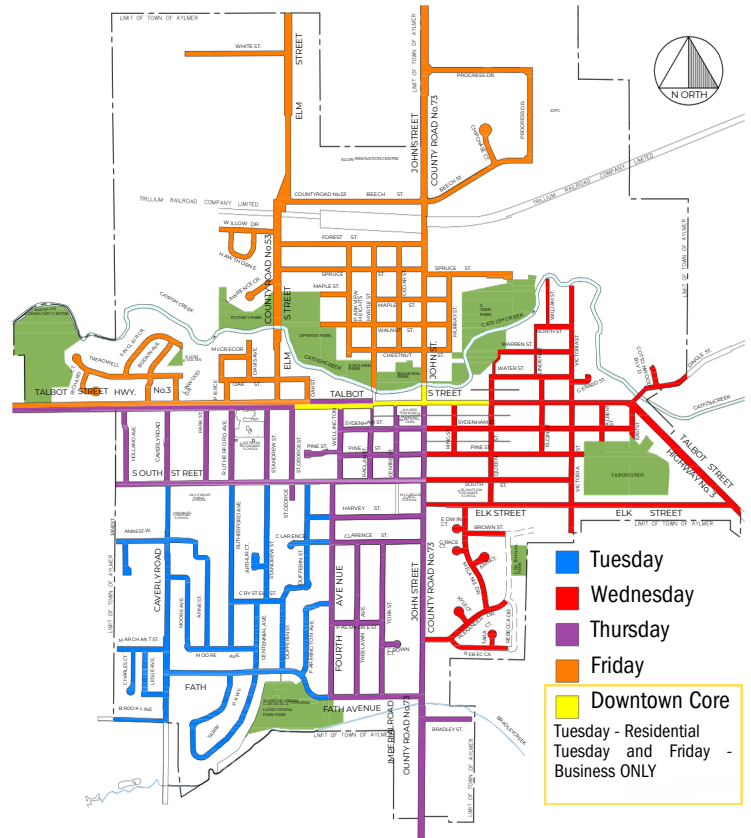

## ACCEPTABLE BLUE BOX ITEMS

### PAPER PRODUCTS

- Magazines, catalogues, phone books
- Newspapers, flyers
- Egg cartons, cardboard boxes, pizza boxes

Cardboard must be flattened and bundled to no larger than 75 cm x 75 cm x 20 cm (30" x 30" x 8")



### CONTAINERS

- Glass bottles, jars
- Plastics including clamshell containers
- Rigid plastic packaging #1-7
- Cartons, drink boxes
- Steel, aluminum, metal cans
- Aluminum foil, foil pie plates
- Spiral wound containers
- Paper cups/lids
- Ice cream tubs, boxes and cartons
- Empty metal paint cans (lids removed)
- Empty aerosol cans (lids removed)

\*Please rinse containers and detach lids where possible
