ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Town of Aylmer is moving forward with the Library Expansion Project based on Design Option 1 proposed by JPM Architecture Inc. and endorsed by Council. This design expands and modernizes the library while preserving the heritage character of the Old Town Hall and enhancing community access to library and cultural services.

This project will be funded through a combination of municipal investment and community fundraising. Community contributions are an important part of bringing this project to life.

SUMMARY OF DESIGN OPTION 1

Key features include:

- A two-storey addition on the west side
- A single-storey addition extending into the park space on the south
- A design that is contemporary yet sensitive, with the new construction touching the original building as lightly as possible
- Improved integration between the library, theatre, and public spaces
