Construction Notice - John Street North

To Whom It May Concern,

The Town of Aylmer will soon be starting construction of a new sidewalk on your street. This letter provides details about the project and important information on how construction may impact you.

Scope: New concrete sidewalk on the east side of John Street North.

Impacts During Construction:

Traffic: Traffic will be reduced at times. There will be select periods of time where driveway access may be restricted or denied for a few days during concrete curing. Notice will be provided by the contractor. If driveway access is restricted, please park your vehicle on the street or nearest side street.

Vibration: Construction equipment can cause vibrations. Please ensure you protect any valuables susceptible to damage.

Private Sprinkler Systems, Landscaping or Fencing: The Town would ask that all items on Town property be removed in advance of construction. The Town is not responsible for damage to items located on Town property.

Sod: The contractor will water new sod following placement. It would be helpful if property owners also watered the sod during this time. After the 60-day sod warranty period watering becomes your responsibility as it was prior to construction.

Safety: Stay safe and avoid the work area during construction. Maintain a safe distance from construction vehicles entering and leaving the site.
